RULES AND REGULATIONS

All fees, MHJA numbers and signatures must accompany entry blank or an open check must be sent with entry. Please make checks payable to: **North Adams Farm.**

ENTRIES CLOSE ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE SHOW (8-18-12). POST ENTRY FEE \$25.00 FOR ANY **NEW** ENTRY MADE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE. RNE (RIDING NOT ENTERED) = \$5.00. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

A grounds fee of \$40.00 per day (schooling day too!) will be charged to anyone not stabling on the grounds. Non-showing horses will be charged \$35.00 in addition to their stall and EMT fee. Horses may be scratched with written notice to show secretary and entries will be refunded. No refund on stalls. NSF check fee = \$40.00.



Schooling after noon on Friday and until 7:30 AM on show days.

All classes will be run according to MHJA rules. **Further rules and class descriptions can be found at www.mhja.org.** That which is not covered by MHJA rules will be in accordance with USEF rules.

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet when mounted. Any rider violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. "The MHJA, North Adams Farm, Win-A-Gin Farms make no representation or warranty, express or implied, about any protective head gear and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk".

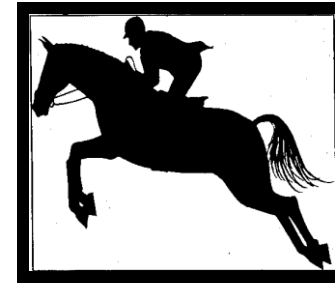
Stabling will consist of 10 x 10 stalls with fronts under a permanent roof. No bedding will be provided. **Call Sally King @ 248-628-2296 for stabling and advance shavings orders.**

In order to accumulate points in any MHJA division, the horse must be recorded with the MHJA. Owners in hunter divisions and all equitation riders must be current members in good standing of the MHJA.

Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or divide classes where entries warrant.
Dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds.



Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Championship and Reserve ribbons in designated divisions. Ten ribbons will be awarded in the Harvey Wallbanger Memorial Hunter Classic. All prize money will be deducted from entries.

RULES/STANDARDS/GRIEVANCE

HUNTER DIVISIONS

A minimum of 3 competitors in a division must be judged in order to have points awarded. Points are awarded according to the number of horses judged in the first hunter over fences class in that division at the show, even if there are less horses competing in this division during the remaining days of the show. **EXCEPTIONS:** Beginner Divisions: ½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in the class

Warm Up: Open to all horses and riders.

Beginner Junior Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in any recognized hunter class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner Junior division do not lose their primary status. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Competing in any classes 2'6" or higher make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division.

½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in a class.

Fences 2'. No Oxers. No In & Outs.

Beginner Adult Hunter: Open to adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in any recognized hunter class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner Adult division do not lose their primary status. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division.

½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in a class.

Fences 2'. No Oxers. No In & Outs.

Very Green Working Hunter: Open to all riders including professionals. Open to horses in their first year of showing over fences. May cross enter into the Regular Member Baby Green Hunter division. Ineligible to compete in the Regular Member Baby Green Hunter division the following show season. A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged in order to have points awarded. **Fences 2' 3" – 2'6"**

Primary Junior Working Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Competing in classes 2' 9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged to have points awarded. **Fences 2' 3".**

Primary Adult Working Hunter: Open to adult riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Competing in classes 2' 9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged to have points awarded. **Fences 2' 3".**

Intermediate Junior Working Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Competing in classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged to have points awarded **Fences 2' 6".**

Intermediate Adult Working Hunter: Open to adult riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Competing in classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged to have points awarded

Fences 2' 6".

Open Working Hunter: Open to all horses and riders. **Fences 2' 6" - 2' 9".**



"Fossils Over Fences": Eligibility is at rider and trainer discretion (If you feel this class was made for you, **as a rider**, then it was!) Trotting not penalized. Only the six best fences to count (judge's discretion). Limited number of horses to canter together in the under saddle class!
Fences 2'3". No Oxers

Horse Of A Different Color: Open to all riders on horses which are not the typical chestnut, bay, brown, gray or black in color

Fences 2' 3". No Oxers.

Harvey Wallbanger Hunter Classic: Horses must have shown in at least two classes over fences at the show. Professionals not to ride. All horses to jump a first round of not less than 10 fences shown over a course using fences in both rings. **Fence heights to be 2' 6".** Top 12 horses (or top 50% depending on number of entries) will return in reverse order to jump a shortened course. Ties, for first place only, will jump a third round in their original order. There will be a posted order of go.

Prize money: 1st=\$100.00, 2nd=\$75.00, 3rd=\$50.00, 4th=\$40.00, 5th=\$35.00, 6th=\$25.00. 7th – 10th = Ribbons.

Entry Fee = \$25.00. Prize money will be deducted from entries.

Walk-Trot: Riders may cross enter W-T-C and pole piles. Riders may NOT enter Crosspole or Beginner divisions except for under saddle and flat classes.

Walk-Trot-Canter: Riders may cross enter poles piles and crosspole divisions. Riders may NOT enter Beginner divisions except for under saddle and flat classes. Horses may canter one at a time if entries warrant.

Pole Pile: Open to very beginner riders of any age. Multiple riders will be allowed on the same horse. Course to consist of poles on the ground. Riders may cross enter into the Crosspole division but NOT the Beginner divisions except for under saddle and flat classes.

Crosspole Hunter (Junior & Adult): - Open to very beginner junior and adult riders. Trotting will not be penalized. May choose to cross enter into either the Pole Pile division or the Beginner division BUT NOT BOTH!

Lesson Horse Classes: These classes are open to any eligible rider, according to class specifications, on a horse who is regularly used in any lesson program. Riders may cross-enter into regular classes according to class specifications.

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

For equitation classes, a minimum of 3 competitors must be judged in order to have points awarded. **EXCEPTIONS:** Beginner Junior & Adult Equitation, Intermediate Adult Medal, Junior/Adult Mini Medal: ½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in class.

Crosspole Equitation (Junior & Adult): Open to very beginner junior and adult riders. Trotting will not be penalized. May choose to cross enter into either the Pole Pile division or the Beginner division **BUT NOT BOTH!**

Beginner Junior Equitation: Open to junior riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders do retain their beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner Junior division do not lose their Primary status. Ribbons won in Equitation on the flat classes do not affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in Eq. over fences classes DO affect eligibility on the flat. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. ½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in a class.

Fences 2'. No Oxers. No In & Outs, No Tests.

Beginner Adult Equitation: Open to adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders do retain their beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner Adult division do not lose their Primary status. Ribbons won in Equitation on the flat classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in Eq. over fences classes DO affect eligibility on the flat. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. ½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in a class.

Fences 2'. No Oxers. No In & Outs, No Tests.

Primary Junior and Adult Equitation: Open to junior or adult riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation On The Flat classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation Over Fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation Over Fences classes DO affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation On The Flat classes. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Competing in any classes 2'9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division.

A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged in order to have points awarded.

Fences 2'3"

Intermediate Junior and Adult Equitation: Open to junior or adult riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation on the flat classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation over fences classes DO affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation on the flat classes. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Competing in any classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. A minimum of 3 competitors must be judged to have points awarded. **Fences 2'6".**

MEDAL CLASSES

A minimum of 4 competitors must complete the course in order to qualifying the winner for the medal finals. Exception: Intermediate Adult Medal and Junior/Adult Mini Medal where the top 15 point accumulators in these classes during the season will qualify to compete in the medal finals. ½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in the class.

MHJA JR/Adult Mini Medal: Open to Junior and Adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in a recognized Equitation class at MHJA, MHSA, or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders may not have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions at MHJA, MHSA, or USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Riders having won do not lose their Novice, Primary, or Short Stirrup status. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect adult rider eligibility. Ribbons won in Equitation on the flat classes DO NOT affect rider eligibility in Equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation over fences classes DO affect rider eligibility in Equitation on the flat classes. Riders do retain their status for the current show season. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider IMMEDIATELY ineligible for this division. The top 15 point accumulators in this class during the season will qualify to compete in the Medal Finals. 1/2 points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in the class. Courses to be simple in nature.

No oxers. No in & outs.

Fences 2'. Tests 1-6. Judges are encouraged to test the top 4 riders.

Entry Fee = \$20.00 ***\$2.00 per entry donated to the MHJA Scholarship Fund.

MHJA Intermediate Junior and Adult Medal: Open to junior and adult riders who are current members, in good standing, of the MHJA who have not won 9 blue ribbons in ANY equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation On The Flat classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in Medal classes. However, ribbons won in Medal classes DO affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation On The Flat classes. Competing in any classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this medal. To show over a figure 8 course of not less than 6 fences, which must include one combination and 2 changes of direction. One rider per horse. Top four riders to test.

Juniors-must win one blue or one red ribbon to qualify for the final ride-off. Junior riders may continue to show until they have won two blue ribbons. Four riders must complete the course for the winner to qualify for the Medal Finals.

Adults-Top 15 point accumulators during the season will qualify for the Medal Finals. ½ points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors in the class.

Note - Winning the Intermediate Medal Final Ride-Off **does not** eliminate a rider from riding in the Intermediate Equitation division.

Fences 2' 6". Tests 1-8.

Entry Fee = \$20.00 ***\$2.00 per entry donated to the MHJA Scholarship Fund.

Open Equitation: Open to all junior and adult riders. Not open to professionals.

Fences 2'6" - 2'9"

AND A \$10 RECORDING FEE FOR THE HORSE MUST BE PAID ANNUALLY

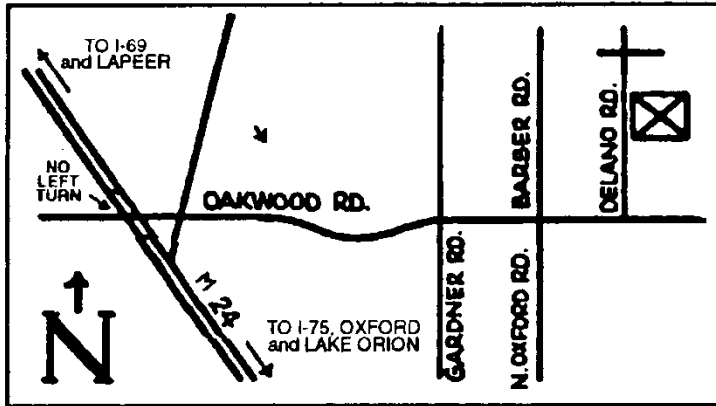
MHJA MEDALS: Riders MUST be a member to compete in any MHJA Medal Classes

Application for Memberships must be made prior to or during the MHJA Approved Show for which you wish points to be awarded toward the MHJA Annual Championships. All members must be in good standing.

DIRECTIONS TO WIN-A-GIN FARMS

From I-69: Exit M-24 south (approx 10 miles) to Oakwood Rd (blinker light). Turn left (East) on Oakwood Rd and go 4 miles to Delano Rd. Turn left (North) on Delano Rd. Win-A-Gin Farms is 1/2 mile on the right.

From I-75: Exit M-24 north, go through Lake Orion & Oxford to Oakwood Rd (Oakwood is the blinker light approx. 2 miles north of Meijers in Oxford). Turn right (East) on Oakwood Rd and go 4 miles to Delano Rd. Turn left (North) on Delano Rd. Win-A-Gin Farms is 1/2 mile on the right.
